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## The future of adult social care

### Adult Social Care Recruitment Campaign

The <u>Adult Social Care (ASC) Recruitment Campaign</u> was officially launched on 3 February 2025 by the Department of Health and Social Care. This campaign will be running through February and March highlighting the amazing work that all staff across the ASC sector do and emphasising the importance in the values required to undertake a career in adult social care.

## **Guidance and Good Practice**

## Safe use of bed rails

Bed rails can be an effective way to reduce the risk of people falling out of bed. However, there continues to be incidents relating to bed rails and associated equipment leading to patient harm or death, primarily from entrapment.

Bed rails are medical device which fall under the authority of the Medicines and Healthcare Products Regulatory Agency (MHRA). In 2023 they updated the <u>guidance</u> for all users, carers and staff with responsibility for the provision, prescription, use, maintenance and fitting of bed rails. The guidance includes case studies, maintenance checks and risk assessments.

## Adult Social Care Learning and Development Support Scheme

On the 5th February, the Department of Health and Social Care published <u>updated</u> guidance for adult social care employers in England on learning and development support for the financial year 2024 to 2025.

The updates include clarification about learning programmes available through training providers licensed by Skills for Care and those directly on the Skills for Care website, and amended funding information for Mental Health First Aid England.

## Leicestershire County Council updates

### Support at Home – Tender Opportunity

A tender opportunity has been published on ProContract. This tender seeks a single provider to work county-wide to support people with eligible social care needs with their non-personal care related needs, for example cleaning, laundry and befriending. This is a pilot and will initially operate for 12 months.

The tender pack is available on <u>ProContract.</u> The closing date for bids is 17<sup>th</sup> March 2025.
