Primary, Secondary School and Post 16 Engagement Careers Fairs and Events

The Workforce Team has attended 27 events across the district – working with schools and colleges through the Careers and Enterprise Hubs and Leicestershire Education Business Company (LEBC), to provide sessions that allow students to explore a variety of careers and engage in sessions, inspiring students to consider a Career in Childcare. Sessions include 'What's my Job', Mock Interviews and Speed Networking, alongside some of the busiest Careers Fairs we have attended to date!!!





This also includes extended teaching and learning sessions for students completing Childcare qualifications at college, as well as secondary schools who offer vocational Health and Social Care and Child Development GCSE options. The students receive information relating to the Childcare sector, explore the range of employment opportunities, advice and guidance around routes into the sector and support around building a sustainable career in the Childcare Workforce, all combined with practical activities to introduce the Early Years Foundation Stage Curriculum (EYFS) which show the value of play to children's learning, progress and development. It is a real pleasure to spend time with the students, here is a snapshot of our activity completed at Brocks Hill Primary, Gartree high, Hastings High, Loughborough College and SMB College Group.
