## 1. Teachers New to Year 6 Training

This important training will be delivered by experienced local authority moderators, giving insight into the 2025/2026 assessment and moderation requirements. Delegates will become familiar with the demands of the Teacher Assessment Framework for writing and take part in a range of activities. The training will be delivered to meet the needs of teachers experiencing national curriculum assessments for the first time and for those more experienced teachers who are returning to the year group after a break or teaching it for the first time. Cost for attendance is free for maintained schools and £55 per delegate for academies. Each session is a repeat and delegates need only chose one.

Delegates will also have an opportunity to develop their subject knowledge in the teaching of writing at greater depth. Delegates may bring examples of their pupils' writing if they wish. Cost for attendance is free for maintained schools and £90 per delegate for academies. Each session is a repeat and delegates need only chose one.
