Skills Bootcamps are intensive, flexible courses designed to rapidly build your skills in a specialised area. Our accredited SEN Coordinator (SENCO) programme is tailored specifically for those qualified at level 3 or above. The course focuses on equipping staff with the knowledge, skills and behaviours to become a qualified SENCO in their setting, support SEND children and meet EYFS standards.

Is this course right for you?

This course is perfect for those currently working in early years settings and already have a level 3 Early Years Educator qualification. It provides a unique opportunity to specialise as a SEN Coordinator in your setting and deepen your understanding of SEN code of practice.

How will learning take place?

Our flexible online programme offers immersive and practical learning through live classes. Learners can choose from a morning, afternoon, evening or weekend study session to fit around their busy schedules. Twice a week, learners will complete a 2.5 hour classes with their peers to build confidence and share their experiences.

What's covered in the course?

Learners will achieve a level 3 NCFE Cache Award for SEN Coordinators in Early Years Settings.

This course covers a range of topics essential for delivering effective support for children with SEND. Learners will gain in-depth knowledge in areas such as roles and responsibilities of a SENCO, social, emotional, speech and language development, including the impact of COVID-19.
