

Get Streetwise – Choose Your Own Adventure Challenge Year 8 Lesson

Teacher's Notes

This lesson revolves around the choices pupils make when travelling independently.

Story Writing

The majority of this lesson sees pupils beginning to write a chooseyour-own-adventure story, with the aid of resources found in the lesson pack. There are three lesson options:

- 45-minute lesson pupils fill out the printed worksheet, with a story plan for a choose-your-own-adventure story.
- 45-minute lesson pupils fill out the printed worksheet, with a story plan for a choose-your-own-adventure story. Teachers then print out the book template, and give to pupils who want to write up the story in their own time.
- 2-hour split lesson pupils fill out the printed worksheet, with a story plan for a choose-your-own-adventure story. All pupils then write out the story in printed book templates.

Any completed stories can be submitted to the Leicestershire County Council Road Safety team. A panel will then judge the best three stories, and the authors of those stories will win a prize (see Competition Information sheet in lesson pack).

- An example of a completed story plan is included in the lesson pack, should you want to distribute this amongst the class.
