Re: Safer Recruitment Checks

I write to confirm that Leicestershire County Council are aware of its responsibilities and obligations with regards to ensuring that all employees who are working with children in schools are subject to the necessary safeguarding checks in line with Keeping Children Safe in Education 2025. This document will be updated on each DBS renewal and annually (September) on updates of the above document.

I confirm that all Leicestershire County Council National Standard Educators who deliver Road Safety Education have undergone a DBS check to include a barred list check for those working in a regulated activity. In addition, all Educators are issued with a Leicestershire County Council ID badge that is always carried and shown upon request. No Educator is required to show or give a copy of their DBS certificate to schools.

290. Schools and colleges must obtain written notification from any agency, or third-party organisation, that they have carried out the checks on an individual who will be working at the school or college that the school or college would otherwise perform. In respect of the enhanced DBS check, schools and colleges must ensure that written notification confirms the certificate has been obtained by either the employment business or another such business
