These materials can be photocopied and are intended for use with children of pre-school age in a variety of different settings.

Captions have been added to help any adult in the setting and parents and carers to reinforce positive behaviour.

Suggestions for use:

There are two prompt cards for 'look and listen' in the pack to use with children to encourage them to concentrate in appropriate situations. This can be displayed on the wall or board as a constant reminder or used as 'flashcards' at the beginning of an activity.

All the drawings are supplied in A4 format and can be enlarged or reduced for your own use. They can be used as visual reminders in certain areas e.g. the apron picture placed above the aprons. Also as reminders before an activity e.g. showing the children the picture of how to ride a bike before going out to play.



You could also reduce a picture onto a small card for the child to hold as a personal visual reminder e.g. 'we sit down' could be held and reference made to it during story time if a child finds it hard to sit

The pictures could also be used as reward cards for positive behaviours either for individuals or groups over time. Under the picture you could draw a grid and every time an adult observes the child or group carrying out the behaviour they could add another sticker/symbol or star.
