Key-note speech by Ben Kingston-Hughes

It looks at the issues facing modern children in their transition to school with a wide range of activities and strategies designed to build confidence and encourage self-reliance and resilience. The talk looks at the intrinsic role of joy, wonder and curiosity in every area of children's development and how we can inspire our children to be happy, healthy and confident.
