## **National updates**

#### Changes to the list of 'Full and Relevant' Early Years Qualifications Suitable for delivering the EYFS

We have received reports from colleagues in neighbouring Local Authorities, that settings have received 'Inadequate' Judgements because staff (often Managers) hold qualifications which are no longer deemed 'Full and Relevant' for delivering the EYFS.

We therefore urge all settings to re-check the qualifications held by all staff against the qualifications list; especially managers who must hold a minimum of a level 3. There are two lists which are located <u>HERE</u>

A List for qualifications STARTED prior to 1<sup>st</sup> September 2014 <u>Early years qualifications: pre-September</u> 2014 and a list for qualifications started on or after 1<sup>st</sup> September 2014 <u>Early years qualifications: from 1</u> September 2014

Remember staff who started their Level 3 on or after 1<sup>st</sup> September 2014 must also hold suitable <u>level 2 literacy</u> <u>and numeracy qualifications</u> before they can be counted as LEVEL 3 in ratio.

Newly qualified staff with a level 2 or level 3 early years qualification, awarded after 30 June 2016, must also have either a full paediatric first aid (PFA) or an emergency PFA certificate within 3 months of starting work. If they do not have this you cannot count them in the EYFS staff:child ratios at level 2 or level 3.
