All our work starts with a conversation.

This is important in identifying the most useful role for the EP.



This might involve work at the individual, group and/or whole school level.



All work is reviewed together, and a record of involvement provided.

Review helps us all to identify next steps in supporting children and young people.

Who are EPs?

Educational Psychologists (EPs) are applied psychologists with indepth knowledge of psychological theories and their practical application.

As part of their post graduate training, all EPs have undertaken research. FPs use evidence-based approaches and interventions to empower others, build staff and school capacity to support learning, and promote the social emotional wellbeing of children and young people.
