A general report of the results of the audit will be sent to the practitioner. If there are any concerns regarding an audit, these will be raised with the practitioner via the Federation Leads.

Names and emails of all practitioners completing the audits will be shared with the ISHS to enable the service to offer support to fitters and to cascade details of relevant training and clinical update information.
