- Walking and ambling. Members of these popular groups lead at least three local (Leicestershire) walks per month and, occasionally, out-of-county walks as well. These are usually followed by lunch at a local pub.
- Day trips – including Lyme Park, Cheshire and Nostell Priory, Yorks.
- Holidays – in the past to a number of Warners' Hotels, and, more recently, to Dunster in Somerset. A five-day trip to Kingussie in Scotland is currently planned.
- Self-drive events – to local places of interest, with a guided tour and a lunch or cream tea afterwards.
- A dance afternoon – a chance to practise ballroom, Latin-American, and sequence dancing and to learn new dances under a qualified instructor.
- An association Christmas lunch which is usually attended by our honorary president, the chair of the county council.
