YEARS. THROUGH THIS WORKSHOP WE WILL  
START TO UNDERSTAND HOW WE CAN MANIPULATE  
AND HARNESS THE POWER OF LIGHT TO  
PROJECT AND CREATE IMAGES.

## WHAT WILL THE PUPILS DO & LEARN?

The pupils will, for example, use a  
prism to separate different colours  
of white light, use long exposure  
photography to capture paintings of  
light drawn in mid-air & see Camera  
Obscura & Camera Lucida in action
