FREE World of Work (WOW) Show resources for National Careers Week;

Special WOW Show and teacher **resources** that are being produced to support **National Careers Week 2020, which runs from March 2-6**. The resources have been developed from feedback from various **Hub Leads** and **Careers Leaders** who wanted something short and snappy to launch National Careers Week. The resources consist of:

- a 12 minute Show (tailored for use in assemblies) highlighting 4 different employment sectors and including a package about employability and transferable skills
- a lesson plan for each of **KS3, KS4 and KS5** that links the show content to the curriculum (Gatsby BM 4) and encourages students to find out more about each sector
- a follow up Q&A show available in the fortnight after NCW where a panel of experts can respond to students' questions about these employment opportunities
